Welcome. Please feel free to be masked if you feel more comfortable. There are masks on the table in the back of the church.

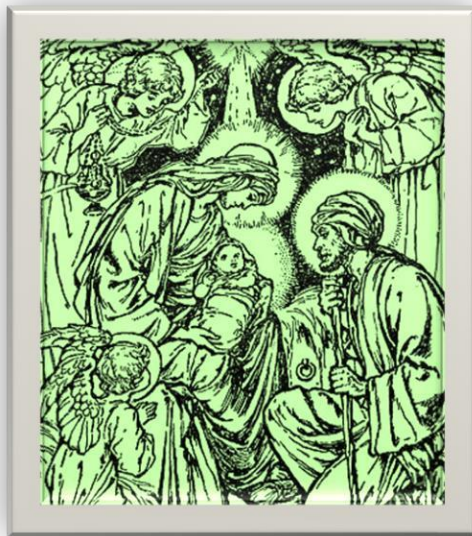
There is a small restroom in the Tower entrance, behind the door, as well as one in the far end of the Hall, and two more down the stairs at the hall entrance.

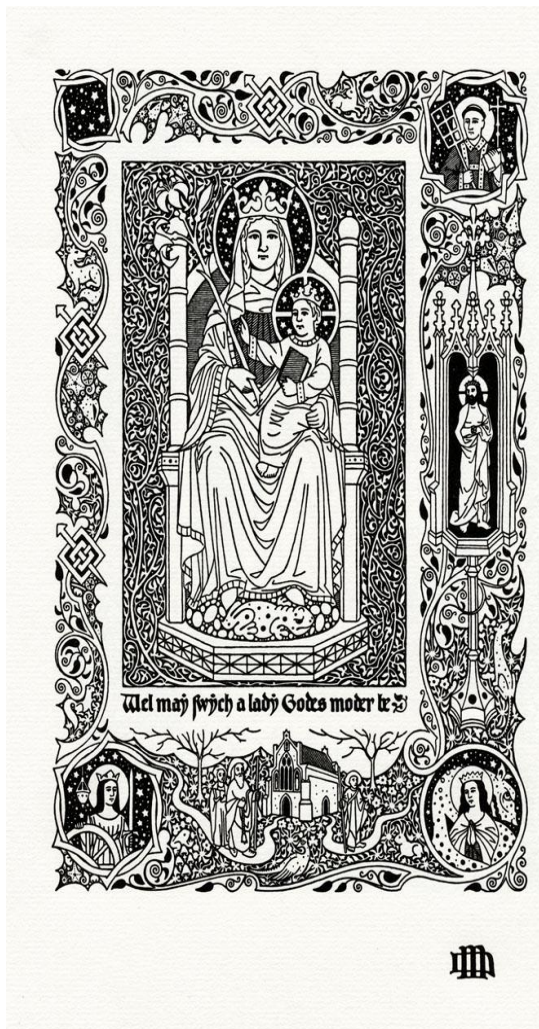

The Gospel

Luke 2:14(15-20)

Therefore with all the angels of heaven we lift our voices to proclaim the glory of your name and sing our joyful hymn of praise:
