Pennsylvania law requires volunteers at People's Emergency Center (PEC) to have up to (3) child clearances, depending on residency. PEC requires clearances must be completed before volunteer's start date at PEC, and be no more than 30 days old.

(3) FBI Background Check if volunteer has lived in PA for less than the last 10 consecutive years.

1. Go to: <https://www.identogo.com/>

2. Click on "Get Fingerprinted."

3. Select "Pennsylvania."

4. Select "Digital Fingerprinting."

5. Enter **Service Code "1KG6ZJ."**

6. Select "Schedule or Manage Appointment."

7. Fill out the form

8. Choose the Identogo site you would like to go to.

9. Select date and time or check "Walk In."

10. Click "Done."

11. Go to the Identogo site. Be sure to bring proper documentation (specified on website). Volunteers will also be asked to sign a conflict of interest form.
