The Most Flawed Census in Modern U.S. History

The 2020 U.S. Census was one of the most flawed in modern American history, with even the Census Bureau admitting there were major issues.

Several factors skewed the results, including the Covid-19 Pandemic making it difficult to count those living in group quarters like college dorms, nursing homes, and correctional facilities. On top of that, the seminal Supreme Court Case Trump v. New York (2020) scuttled efforts to ensure illegal aliens would not be counted.

But the most important factor was the implementation of differential privacy, an opaque algorithmic application that intentionally manipulated census data. Under the guise of protecting user data, differential privacy contributed to massive errors, nullified the ability

of localities to correct mistakes, and concealed the number of non-citizens in the census.

As a result, fourteen states reported significant statistical errors, which has had a major impact on our political system. Our estimate indicates that differential privacy resulted in Democrats illicitly gaining a net of six seats in Congress.

This is a critical issue with long-term implications that must be immediately fixed.

Thankfully, there are solutions.

The Path Forward: Correcting the Record

President Trump has rightly called out the 2020 U.S. Census for what it is; a completely inaccurate and politically biased count of the American public. As we outlined in our recent policy papers, there are several ways to fix this.

First, Trump must put in place trusted personnel in the U.S. Census Bureau who can undo the damage of 2020 and reform the census going forward. They need to clear out the Obama bureaucrats in charge, and re-release the 2020 Census with all errors from differential privacy corrected.

Once that's completed, these officials need to revamp how the federal government collects state data, add a mandatory U.S. Citizenship question, and most importantly, eliminate the use of differential privacy.

Recent 2025 polls indicate a growing embrace of socialism among Democrats. Gallup's August survey of 1,094 adults found 66% of Democrats holding positive views of socialism, surpassing their 42% positive rating for capitalism, with support rising since 2010.

- Under President Trump, America's economy is getting back on track, and prices and inflation are down.
 - President Donald J. Trump promised to crush inflation and lower prices — and he's delivering this Thanksgiving, with the classic holiday feast about 3% cheaper than last year, according to a <u>brand new</u> report.
 - Gas prices <u>reached</u> their lowest average price in more than four years.
 - The price of <u>eggs</u> is <u>down</u> 66% since President Trump took office.
 - The average 30-year fixed mortgage rate was <u>6.17%</u> at the end of October — 12% lower than when President Trump took office
