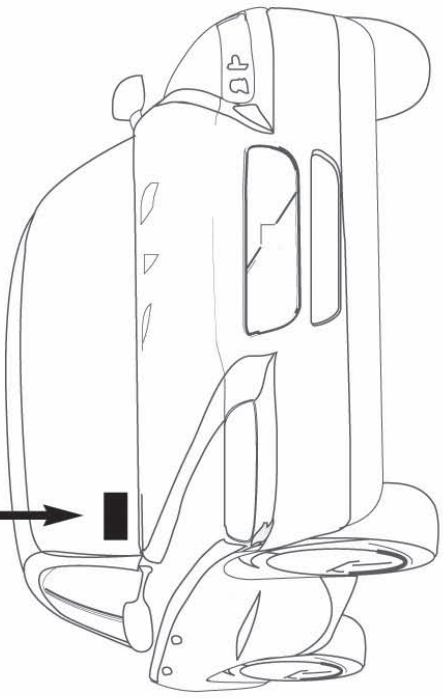

INSTRUCTIONS

- Before applying your sticker, make sure the glass surface is clean and dry
- Carefully remove sticker from paper backing and smooth onto glass
- While applying sticker, use the edge of a credit card (or other hard piece of plastic) to press out any bubbles

Position your parking sticker on the inside right front windshield, number facing forward



Parking on Campus - All students, faculty, staff, and other persons affiliated with the University (contractors, vendors, etc.) who operate and park a motor vehicle on the Hammond or Baton Rouge campuses must properly display a current parking hang-tag or decal on their vehicle, and must be parked in a designated parking space.
