Vision 2020's national coalition of Delegates and Allied Organizations and its Proud Partners in Women 100 are honoring the contributions of American women past and present while raising civic awareness and engagement to new heights. We have planned a diverse calendar of activities to celebrate women's history and spark new ideas about the path forward to greater gender equality.

Vision 2020's *Women 100* includes Vision2020Votes, a nonpartisan, national voter mobilization effort encouraging women to vote in record numbers in the 2020 elections.

### Toast To Tenacity™

**Wednesday, August 26, 2020** FREE VIA WEBCAST

August 26, the day the 19th Amendment became law in 1920, is recognized nationwide as Women's Equality Day. To celebrate the centennial, Vision 2020 will host a limited-seating program of presentations and tributes in the shadow of Independence Hall. This live-streaming and prerecorded webcast will include well-known speakers and musical performances. A 1 pm ET toast to the suffragists will include similar toasts in other cities.



### SHE Leads Road Rally FREE VIA WEBCAST

**Friday–Saturday, October 16-17, 2020**

On this road trip from America's Birthplace to the Birthplace of Women's Rights, women driving race cars and vintage automobiles will lead a spirited motorcade from Philadelphia to Seneca Falls, NY, site of the first Women's Rights Convention. Follow this spectacular road rally online from home and retrace this early path to women's empowerment for an unforgettable celebration of women's voting rights and other achievements over the past 100 years.

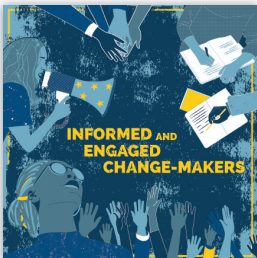


## Seat at the Table Exhibition
