

St. Mary Middle School Summer Reading 2019

Congratulations on completing another fantastic school year, and welcome to summer 2019! In order to keep your minds sharp and your imaginations active over the summer, we're sending you out with a summer reading assignment, which you should read *carefully*, complete *fully*, and turn in *promptly* by August 16, 2019 (the first Friday of school; students may turn projects in as early as August 14).

Each student will be required to turn in a project on the book assigned (Due by August 16).

Books

6th Grade

Any book from the Percy Jackson series by Rick Riordan: Twelve-year-old Percy Jackson learns he is a demigod, the son of a mortal woman and Poseidon, god of the sea. AR Level: 4.1+

Project Options (choose one)

6th Grade:

Option A: Create a comic book based on your book. Each page should be set up in a comic book format with illustrations and captions. Your comic book should retell the main ideas of the story including setting, characters, and all major events, conflicts, and turning points of the story. There must be captions and dialogue in your comic book. There must be a minimum of 15 complete sentences. Your assignment must be neatly written or typed.

Option B: Think about all the kinds of mementos you would put into a scrapbook if you had one. Choose a character from the book and create a scrapbook page showing how the character's experiences relate to the book. Use pictures, words, and/or your own drawings and put them together on one piece of paper. You must also include at least one quotation from the book. Write an explanation of how some of the mementos on your scrapbook relate to the book. There must be a minimum of 15 complete sentences. Your assignment must be neatly written or typed.

Bonus Opportunity:

Students may choose to read an additional book of their choice. This needs to be a book that has not been read before summer 2019. Also, the book choice needs to be a chapter book and have an appropriate AR level for your student. Students will be required to take an AR test on their chosen book, receive an 80% or higher, and have the slip below signed by the student and parent to receive bonus points. You can check the AR level of a book and see if there is an AR test available at

www.arbookfind.com.
