Ranging from ages 14 to 18, members come from across the greater Seattle area to meet artists, explore exhibitions and collections, and collaborate on projects such as zines, art shows, videos, and more!

As a member of the Collective, you will meet weekly and work alongside a teaching artist to go behind the scenes of the museum, meet artists and creative professionals in Seattle, and collaborate with new friends on Collective-driven projects.
