

Center's Writing Center Information

Purpose:

The Center School's Writing Center aims to support students as they tackle writing work across their classes. We will do this by providing space and time during the school day for collaboration about writing, from brainstorming to final product.

Advantages to Tutors:

- May be able to earn credit
- Learn how to support others as you write
- Become aware and improve your own writing process
- Build community by filling a need at TCS
- Make connections with students you may not otherwise meet
- Help improve the sense of virtual community

Writing Center Tutors' Requirements:

- Must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade
- Attend three (3) virtual whole-group trainings prior to the opening of the Writing Center
- Attend monthly trainings/meetings
- Be in the Writing Center for a *minimum* of twelve (12) sessions November through January.
- Complete all readings and other activities for the trainings
- Conference with students *at least* six (6) times during your semester-long term
- Write an end-of-semester reflection
- Share own writing with Writing Center tutors
- Manage the running and growing of the Writing Center
