As we begin week two of the in-person school reopening, I have included information on the Appeals process and the form link. Please note that all schools have a designated room capacity which must be adhered to per SPS Safety and Health protocols, so some appeals for in-person return may not be granted by Enrollment next week.

APPEALS

In Person Learning Appeal Process and Expectations

All current K-5 students who want to change their learning preference to remote or in person must file an appeal. Appeals will be reviewed by the Admissions office in order of circumstances, and they are not guaranteed. Students with an extenuating circumstance will be considered as priority i.e. student did not receive a survey or those receiving McKinney Vento and Foster Care services. Students in grades 6-12 who are not receiving Special Education Intensive pathways services should work their school to update their learning preference for the remainder of the week. Beginning on April 26, students in grades 6-12 will submit an appeal in order to change their learning preference. The appeals process and form is available [here](#).

Principals will be notified by the Admissions office to verify in-person learning capacity prior to coordinating approvals. Principals will also need to confirm the cohort and date of return for any approval. All decisions will be made timely to streamline the process without further delay so school administrators should prioritize these notifications as they are received. Families will be notified by the Admissions team with the final decision. Upon approving the appeal for in-person learning, the Admissions team will update Power School accordingly and email both the family and school staff of students results and start date.
