

## **Worship Services at Trillium - March 2021**

**Effective Sunday, March 7,** Trillium will again open the sanctuary on Sunday morning for a limited number of worshipers. This is intended for those whose worship needs may not be served by the on-line webinar service. Worship services on Sunday will continue to be accessible by internet or phone. Youth services will also continue as on-line meetings with phone access.

**If the weather is inclement,** please call the church office first or check Trillium's website before coming to the church. Cancellations due to weather will be on the office phone greeting and on the website by 9am.

The Re-Opening Team is committed to making the worship experience in the sanctuary as safe as possible. Here is what you need to know if you come to the sanctuary:

- The on-line worship service will be shown on the projection screen. Worship leaders will be on-line (not in the church).
- A three-ply mask must be worn at all times and must cover the nose and mouth. Those who arrive without a mask will be provided with one.
- If you cannot wear a mask for medical reasons you will be seated in a designated distanced seating area.
- High touch surfaces (door handles, washrooms, pews) will be sanitized before the service.
- Volunteer greeters and ushers will be present to assist you to follow the safety protocols. Attendance will be taken.
- You will be asked to maintain 2 metres (6 foot) distance from those not in your family group. Ushers will seat you at a safe distance from others.
- Once you are seated, please remain there until the end of the service. Greet people from a safe distance (2 metres).
- Singing is a high-risk activity and is not recommended. Please hum or clap along to songs.
- There is no nursery care for infants and toddlers.
- Coffee and fellowship will not be held in the church. You may visit with others before or after the service but outside the church building.
- Please stay home if you feel unwell or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
