| 71. | Patient Cottat Anciennes Vignes Sancerre 2018, France | \$35 |
| | <i>Lemon with golden-green reflections. Complex and intense aromas of acacia blossoms with a Muscat-like nose of passionfruit. Very well balanced. Notes of litchi and a small touch of honey.</i> | |
| 72. | Long Shadows Poet's Leap Riesling 2018, Columbia Valley | \$25 |
| | <i>Juicy kumquat and lively grapefruit laced with hints of white peach and honey with a pleasing minerality throughout. Beautifully balanced with racy acidity, the off-dry finish is long and clean.</i> | |
| 73. | Orin Swift Cellars Mannequin Chardonnay 2017, California | \$39 |
| | <i>Meyer lemon, vanilla crème, and sweet oak. Jasmine, gardenias and caramel. Stone fruit, melon, lemon curd, roasted almond, grapefruit pith and white pepper. A long and rich finish of young coconut.</i> | |
| 74. | Bouchard Pere & Fils Chassagne-Montrachet 2017, Burgundy | \$85 |
| | <i>Intense floral and fruit aromas on the nose. Full-bodied, rich and smooth, with a lingering aftertaste.</i> | |
| 75. | Chateau Montelena Chardonnay 2017, Napa Valley | \$60 |
| | <i>Peach, apricot, and honeydew. Citrus blossom and rose water. Fresh pear and cinnamon. Lemon curd with bright acid, green apple, and toast. with a hint of white pepper and plenty of orange zest.</i> | |
| 76. | Kosta Browne One Sixteen Chardonnay 2018, Russian River (375ml) | \$45 |
| | <i>Pure, with bright lemon zest, honeysuckle, cantaloupe and notes of brioche. Precise and intentional entry with a lively energetic mid-palate, focused acidity and a round, nimble weight.</i> | |
| 77. | Kosta Browne One Sixteen Chardonnay 2018, Russian River (750ml) | \$85 |
| | <i>Pure, with bright lemon zest, honeysuckle, cantaloupe and notes of brioche. Precise and intentional entry with a lively energetic mid-palate, focused acidity and a round, nimble weight.</i> | |
| 78. | Rochioli Estate Chardonnay 2018, Russian River | \$65 |
| | <i>This straw-yellow wine has a concentrated aroma of Ripe apple, apricot, vanilla, and a touch of spice. The rich apple flavors and crisp acidity with a hint of hazelnut for a long, balanced finish.</i> | |
| 79. | Hall Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Napa Valley | \$28 |
| | <i>Gooseberry, fresh cut grass, juicy mango, lemon rind, and grapefruit. Dry with crisp acidity and a palate of pineapple, lemon, lime, minerality, and rich creaminess developed by stirring the lees in tank.</i> | |
| 80. | Orin Swift Cellars Blank Stare Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Russian River | \$37 |
| | <i>Lemongrass, fresh-cut grass and hints of lavender, cream, and jasmine. The entry is all acidity with flavors of kiwi, lime, and minerality. The finish is bright and youthful with a slight Meyer lemon rind.</i> | |
| 81. | Duckhorn Chardonnay 2017, Napa Valley (375ml) | \$22 |
| | <i>Aromas of nectarine, yellow plum, pineapple upside-down cake, and sweet spices. On the palate, zesty acidity and an underlying silkiness. French oak-inspired hints of vanilla, sweet dough and clove.</i> | |

83. **Santa Margherita Prosecco Superiore, Italy** **\$30**
Aroma will remind you of peaches and sweet flowers. Flavors include fruity hints of pineapples and Rennet apples. Dry with fine, lively bubbles, delicate pear, and apple fruit aromas and a crisp finish.
84. **Emmolo Sauvignon Blanc 2017, Napa Valley** **\$25**
Scents of white peach and guava. On the palate an acidity balanced by flavors of peach and honeydew. A tart, smooth texture that lingers in the mouth. The mouth-watering finish is unusually bright and crisp.
85. **Cakebread Chardonnay 2017, Napa Valley** **\$53**
A floral nose with fresh citrus, orange blossom and white peach. Viscosity coats the palate but is well balanced with acidity. Finishes with a lingering minerality intertwined with pear and apple lemon.
86. **DAOU Vineyards Reserve Chardonnay 2018, Paso Robles** **\$35**
Aromas of pineapple and lemon pie accompanied by wonderful notes of vanilla and hazelnut flavors. A creamy and fleshy texture with a finish that lingers on the palette and tantalizes the senses.
87. **PlumpJack Reserve Chardonnay 2018, Napa Valley** **\$50**
Aromas of Meyer lemon, pomelo, green pear, honeysuckle, and orange blossom with toast and apple cinnamon. The palate is creamy, silky, and bright, with sensations of great weight and vibrant freshness.
88. **DAOU Vineyards Rosé 2019, Paso Robles** **\$24**
Fresh strawberry, sliced peach, watermelon. Hibiscus, cherry, clover honey. Nectarine, orange, strawberry parfait, golden delicious apple. Papaya, honeydew melon. Peach, citrus zest, Barbados cherry.
89. **Emmolo Methode Traditionelle Sparkling Wine No. 2, California** **\$40**
Produced on Méthode Traditionelle. Features soft bubbles and freshness that yields to creaminess from extended aging. Blend: 56% Chardonnay, 44% Pinot Noir
90. **DAOU Vineyards Chardonnay 2019, Paso Robles** **\$24**
Bosc pear, pineapple, guava. Hibiscus flower, white peach and allspice. Honeysuckle and vanilla. Tropical fruit and warm toast. Lush and silky with melon, mango, pineapple and vanilla crème brûlée.
91. **G.H. Mumm, Champagne Brut Grand Cordon** **\$42**
Toast and dried fruit notes mix in this dry Champagne. Dried apricot, candied orange peel, nut and smoke- but still elegant and light weight. The rich, toasty note lingers on the vibrant finish.
92. **Elouan Rosé 2019, Oregon** **\$20**
Intense fruit flavor, structure, and vibrant acidity. A bespoke rosé with crisp, clean aromas and tastes. A great choice for outdoor occasions: picnics, lunch on the patio, or enjoyed on its own as an aperitif.
93. **TPW Co. Blindfold 2017, California** **\$34**
A luscious entry of toasted hazelnut and mandarin is balanced by bright acidity and minerality. The finish is rich and creamy with flavors of lemon zest and caramelized sugar.

94. **Pascal Jolivet Sancerre 2018, France (375mm)** **\$19**
Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, youthful. Overall, a dry and elegant wine.
95. **Pascal Jolivet Sancerre 2018, France (750ml)** **\$33**
Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, youthful. Overall, a dry and elegant wine.
96. **TPW Co. The Snitch Chardonnay 2016, Napa Valley** **\$32**
Aromas and flavors of dried peach skin, tart citrus, oak, and mineral invite a pairing with oven baked chicken thighs accented with a delicate mango chutney and dried red pepper flakes.
97. **Huia Sauvignon Blanc 2019, Marlborough** **\$22**
Bright floral notes of elderflower and lime blossom. Guava, melon, gooseberry and lime zest. The palate has definite mineral notes balancing the ripe acidity and myriad of fruit and flower flavors.
98. **Chateau Minuty Prestige Rose 2019, France** **\$30**
Pale with pomelo lights. Precise and delicate with notes of flowers and melon, citrus and red fruits. Underlined by a pleasant minerality. Blend: 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Cinsault, 10% Tibouren
99. **Chateau Ste. Michelle Riesling 2017, Columbia Valley** **\$16**
A blend of Riesling from throughout Washington's Columbia Valley. A flavorful, medium-dry Riesling offering crisp apple aromas and flavors with subtle mineral notes.
