Joel Simon is the *founding director* of the Journalism Protection Initiative at the Craig Newmark Graduate School of Journalism, part of the City University of New York. He is the author of four books, including most recently *The Infodemic: How Censorship and Lies Made the World Sicker and Less Free*, co-authored with Robert Mahoney. He writes on press freedom issues for The New Yorker and produces a column for Columbia Journalism Review. From 2006 until 2021, Simon served as executive director of the *Committee to Protect Journalists*. His work defending press freedom was featured in the HBO documentary *Endangered*, which was nominated for an Emmy.

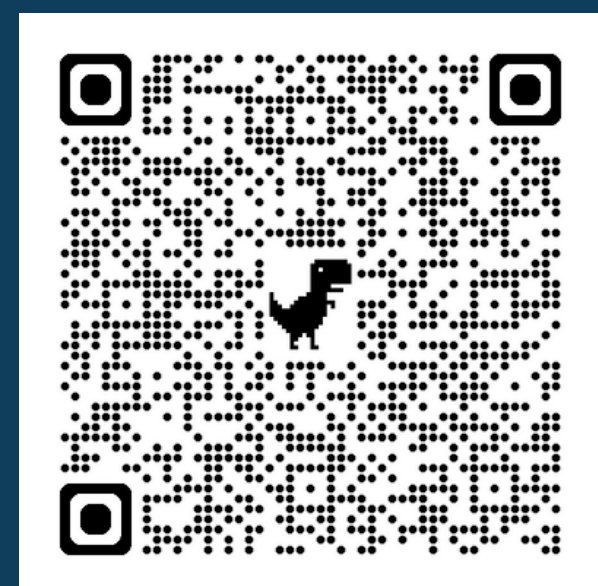
