DAY 1 March 12 USA - International flight, to Lisbon

DAY 2 March 13 LISBON

Arrive in Lisbon and enjoy the Panoramic visit of the city. Lisbon is probably best known for its colonial history, ornate architecture and tradition of Fado music. But some of its best features are in the everyday – spectacular hilltop vistas in Alfama or at St. George's Castle, blue-and-white tile-covered facades. (D)

DAY 5 - March 16 FATIMA - SALAMANCA - AVILA



Breakfast. The city of Ávila is a step back in time, with the invitation to explore its hidden treasures. It was declared a World Heritage Site in 1985. We say goodbye to the sanctuary and Portugal today we will head to Salamanca, Spain, Admire the most important monuments of

Salamanca: Travel back to the Middle Ages and stroll through the city admiring architecture as the Cathedrals and University, Salamanca counts with other historical sites, less known to the general tourist. St. Stephen's Monastery is a part of Spanish history. Home of Francisco de Vitoria (considered the father of International Law) and Cristobal Colón. Wander through its cloisters and rooms, and feel the peace and atmosphere of a monastery still in use. We continue to Avila, a city in Spain, has a strong Catholic heritage, known for its religious sites and the influence of St. Teresa of Avila our pilgrimage today finish in the Avila Gothic Cathedral Accommodation. DAY 6 March 17 AVILA - TOLEDO

Breakfast. The city of Ávila was the birthplace of Saint Teresa, or "La Santa" as she is known here. A visit to the Convent of Santa Teresa, built on the site of the house where she was born, is a must. The church of San Juan Bautista, the place where she was baptised, is also well worth a visit. Enjoy the free time in this medieval town, before go to the hotel we will see great sunsets in the most popular spot at the Humadillero de los Cuatro Postes, a religious monument. It stands outside the walled city, on the other side of the bridge over the Adaja river. The panoramic view of the city is spectacular, with the walls in the foreground against the changing colours of the sky. We continue our journey to the beautiful medieval city of Toledo, known as the "City of Three Cultures" for the harmonious coexistence of Muslims, Christians, and Jews. Upon arrival, we'll enjoy a panoramic tour with a local guide (no entrance fees included). Free time to explore the city at your own pace. (B,D)

tecture, the bustling Ramblas, and its rich history, highlighted by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics hosted here. Together we will explore the oldest part of Barcelona in the city's Gothic Quarter. Walk along La Rambla and see its flower stalls, entertainers, and eateries. Shop at La Boqueria, where over 300 stalls offer a variety of local products. Before heading to the hotel, we will visit Barcelona Cathedral. (B,D)
