



Fuel Waiver

Notice of Biodiesel Outage and Waiver at Flint Hills Resources – Pine Bend, Rosemount, MN

The Flint Hills Resources Pine Bend terminal located in Rosemount, MN has notified the Minnesota Department of Commerce Weights and Measures Division that the terminal did not have biodiesel available for loading at the rack between 7:25 AM, June 7, 2022 and 11:35 AM, June 7, 2022.

Retailers may be granted a waiver under [Minnesota Statutes §239.80](#) on diesel loads bought from Flint Hills Resources Pine Bend terminal in Rosemount during the biodiesel outage if:

1. The retailer, or its purchasing agent, was already an existing customer of Flint Hills Resources Pine Bend terminal in Rosemount at the time of the biodiesel outage;
2. The retailer is obligated to meet the requirements of [Minnesota Statutes §239.77](#) because the retailer sells diesel fuel for use in internal combustion engines; and
3. The retailer had insufficient time to arrange for alternative sources of biodiesel to meet statutory requirements.

The Weights and Measures Division will determine a retailer's eligibility for this waiver through bills of lading or other information obtained by the Weights and Measures Division from the retailer and from Flint Hills Resources Pine Bend terminal in Rosemount under the auditing authority granted in [Minnesota Statutes §§239.011, 239.75, and 239.753](#).

This waiver applies only to loads pulled from the Flint Hills Resources Pine Bend terminal in Rosemount loading rack between 7:25 AM, June 7, 2022, and 11:35 AM June 7, 2022.

Diesel sold for use in combustion engines under any conditions other than those outlined in a waiver granted by the Weights and Measures Division must have the minimum amount of biodiesel required under Minnesota Statutes §239.77, or retailers may face penalties under Minnesota Statutes §239.80.
