### Youth Bureau Advisory Board

The Town of Smithtown Youth Advisory Board is comprised of students and adults from all township communities. These appointed volunteers work with the Youth Bureau to plan and implement town-wide programs.

### Community Needs Assessments

The Town of Smithtown Youth Bureau conducts ongoing community surveying to remain aware of residents' needs. Resources are allocated to focus on issues facing the town's youth and families and to develop community strength.
