

Art Supplies List for Spooktacular Paint Your Own Pumpkin Night 10/15/2021

Large Pumpkin for the family and a few smaller pumpkins for each younger child
4 acrylic paint brushes, small (1/4 inch), medium (1/2 inch), large (2 inch), pencil thin brush

Liquitex Basics Acrylic Paints: (or any student grade set of colors you like)

You'll need a total of **5 different colors AND Black & White**. *The list below is a *suggestion* of colors.
You may choose your own, you MUST have 5 colors, plus black and white for the painting that we are
doing on the pumpkins. Pick up a **LARGE** tube of White acrylic paint, the black and the 5 colors may be
small tubes.

OPTIONAL are silver and gold acrylic paints, glue and silver & gold glitter to decorate your first
pumpkin AND if you choose to do a second pumpkin. The clear glazing/gloss medium is to cover your
painted pumpkin to seal/protect the painting and give a high glass shine to make the image pop!

*Titanium White (large tube)

*Mars Black (small)

*Cobalt Blue (small)

*Cadmium Yellow Deep Hue (looks like Egg Yolk yellow) (small)

*Medium Magenta Pink (small)

*Cadmium Red Light (looks Orange) (small)

*Light Green Permanent (small)

Silver Metallic (small)

Gold Metallic (large- if doing a second pumpkin, small if just using to decorate)

Glitter

Elmer's, dries clear, Glue

Liquitex Glazing Fluid Medium

Empty container (I use glass canning jar) for water

Paper towels

Palette OR paper plate

Newspaper to protect the surface you are working on

IF you want to do a second painting on a pumpkin, you will definitely need:

Gold Acrylic Paint

Glazing/Gloss Medium

Gold Glitter

White Paint

Black Paint

Clear drying (like Elmers) Glue
