Unit 356 Congratulates Ace of Clubs and Mini-McKenney Winners

Tucson, AZ -- ACBL Unit 356 congratulates The Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs and Mini-McKenney winners for 2018. Awards will be presented before play during a special Unit 356 game held Sunday, March 17 at the Adobe Bridge Center.

The Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs winners will receive a certificate for the most 2018 club game wins within their respective masterpoint category. Black points are counted and not points earned in STaCs and other special games paying pigmented points.

In 2011, The Ace of Clubs award is named after Helen Shanbrom, the most successful club player in ACBL history. Helen passed in 2013 at the age of 94.

The Mini-McKenney award is named after William E. McKenney. His originality, drive and organizational ability did much to establish the ACBL. McKenney was the ACBL's first executive secretary and remained at the helm until 1947.
