The name pays homage to the great Edgar Kaplan, the father of modern bridge ethics. Think of EDGAR like a radar gun being used by law enforcement - if it catches you, the ACBL will issue a "cheating ticket" and impose a small suspension (or take other minimal disciplinary action). Members who are ticketed will, of course, have the opportunity to defend themselves (through arbitration in front of the IBA), but we expect EDGAR will clean up the online game considerably.

The ACBL plans a phased process leading to a full deployment of EDGAR. During the latter part of 2022, EDGAR will be used to support "traditional" OEOC investigations as felony cheating cases begin to be referred to the IBA. Expect a complete rollout in early 2023.
