

2018 District 17 Election Report

This year's election of board members for District 17 included some representatives being elected to two-year terms and some being elected to three-year terms. This is the result of transitioning from two-year terms to three-year terms, and from 14 elected board members to 10 elected board members (plus the National Board representative).

The board members elected this year include: John Grossmann (three-year term representing Colorado/Wyoming At Large), W. Lakin Hines (two-year term representing Mesa Unit 351), JoAnne Lowe (three-year term representing Phoenix Unit 354), Felicity Moore (three-year term representing Northern New Mexico At Large), Steve Nordberg (two-year term representing Southern New Mexico/El Paso At Large), Jennifer O'Neill (three-year term representing Denver Unit 361), and Rod Southworth (two-year term representing Colorado/Wyoming At Large).

Future elections will involve electing either three or four board members each year, keeping the number of elected board members to 10. The full 2019 board member roster with the number of years remaining in their term on the board is as follows:
