Goal: To Purchase 100 Instruments for the Marching Hundred

20 Yamaha Baritones Purchased

We are thrilled to announce that the first 20 new instruments for the Marching Hundred have been ordered. 20 Yamaha YEP 211 silver baritones will be arriving in August and will be revealed to the band during band camp week in mid-August. Director David Woodley said that baritones were chosen as the first purchase because the number of baritone players has been increasing steadily. The cost of the new horns was about \$42,000.



\$12,495 Raised From Gifts on IU Day, 2018

Thank you to all those who contributed during the IU Day campaign. We raised \$12,495 towards our overall goal of \$160,000, the amount needed to purchase trumpets, trombones, mellophones and baritones for the Marching Hundred.

Over 138 alumni and friends made a donation and we also received some bonus awards from the IU Foundation bringing our total to over \$13,000.

To date, we have raised over \$44,000. This is a great start towards reaching our \$160,000 goal.
