OUTSIDE LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE JOBS NOT TAKEN

September-March

Keep an eye on your area and take care of it only when it needs your TLC. If you would like, Linda can show you what to do in your space if you snatch a job before November 14^{th} . Once it's cleaned up, nothing much happens until February and March.

Along 7 th are several trees and signs. Keep the areas around those cleared of grass and weeds. We are attempting to have a circle area around each. In the spring after weeding, one big bag of brown barkdust should cover all of those areas.
Weed and rake the barkdusted area from 7 th Street to the Food Cupboard/Office entrance door. After the rhododendrons finish blooming, remove the spent blooms.
Weed the bed along Watson in front of the fence by the stained glass windows. Some perennials die off later this fall. Scoop them up or trim them down to the ground and put them in the yard debris bins.
Your choiceSpray the rocky beds (in front of the church) for stubborn weedsOR Many weeds can be dug up and/or pull out easily.
Rake, trim and weed the beds along the Food Cupboard and Office windows. Stop at the area behind the seating wall near the patio area.
Dig out weeds and rake a bit in the two areas on both sides of the main sidewalk to the front doors of the church. It's okay to pluck out weeds growing through the Scotch Moss ground cover.
