

Pandemic Viral Event Plan Summary

Level 1—Preparedness

- The Jefferson County Public Schools (JCPS) District Level Incident Management Team (DLIMT) is in place to quickly respond if a school needs emergency support.
- The Pandemic Viral Event Plan (PVEP) has been reviewed.

Level 2—Mitigation and Prevention (as determined by the Louisville Metro Department of Public Health and Wellness [LMDPHW])

- Communitywide health surveillance will be increased, and student absences will be monitored.
- Housekeeping practices will be reviewed to ensure that schools are maintaining a clean and sanitized environment.

Level 3—Advanced Precautions (as determined by LMDPHW) JCPS Current Level

- Implement heightened level of awareness, and additional precautionary measures will be added.
- Enhance districtwide disinfectant processes.

Level 4—Initiate Surveillance, Reporting, and Heightened Awareness (as determined by LMDPHW)

- JCPS notified of suspected cases of the virus in Kentucky.
- Intensify monitoring processes, and continue contact with LMDPHW.
- Restrict and/or cancel out-of-county travel for district activities, conferences, etc. as directed by LMDPHW.
- Restrict/Limit public assembly activities as directed by LMDPHW.

Level 5—Preparation for Possible School Closures (as determined by LMDPHW)

- Local health officials will notify JCPS if there has been a confirmed case in Jefferson County.
- Health-related emergency plan will be enacted at both the school and community levels.
- JCPS will work closely with LMDPHW.
- All district travel plans are to be cancelled as directed by LMDPHW.

Level 6—Public Health Emergency Closures (as determined by LMDPHW)

- District will activate school closure procedures (instructed by LMDPHW).
- Information will be released about support of students, staff, and community.

Level 7—Recovery (as determined by LMDPHW)

- Students and employees can return to school/work.
- Crisis support team will be initiated to provide potential support to schools.
