YOU'RE INVITED! ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

- **The Anchor Class:** This class emphasizes fellowship, good discussion, and growth. Studying the book of ACTS. Class is led by David Jump and meets in Room 15 of the Education Building.
- **The Cary Grayson Class:** This class is facilitated by a team of leaders that engage in a study and reflection of the Bible. Studying 1 Chronicles. Class meets in Room 4 of Covenant Hall.
- **The Bible from Scratch: 4 weeks in Genesis:** This is a short tour of the first book of the Bible. God makes so many promises in Genesis- how are they fulfilled then, now, and in the time to come? If you would like a quick and accessible look into the foundations of our faith, join us for any or all of these sessions (1/25, 2/1, 2/8, 2/15). Meets in the library with the LIFE Class. READ GOOD BOOKS IN 2026!

Join Pastor Daniel in reading books covering a variety of topics, authors, and genres. The choices are designed to stimulate the heart and mind and to be a catalyst for growth in discipleship. Read in preparation for the group discussion at 4:00 p.m. on the 4th Sunday of every other month.

On February 22nd we'll discuss Chinua Achebe's *Things Fall Apart*. With more than twenty million copies sold and translated into fifty-seven languages, *Things Fall Apart* provides one of the most illuminating and permanent monuments to African experience. The story follows the tragic life of a high-performing but deeply flawed African native inhabiting an exalted place within his traditional Umuofia society which is under threat from European imperialists. Themes covered are: Colonialism and Cultural Change, Masculinity and Identity, and Tradition vs. Change. (Books are \$10 and available online or in the Narthex.)

The Associate Pastor Nominating Committee (APNC) began its work in April 2024 with prayerful hope and patience. Over eighteen months, God clarified not only the needs of Westminster, but also the kind of leader who would best serve our congregation. We sought someone who would partner well with Pastor Daniel, bring creativity and enthusiasm to adult discipleship, and help strengthen the spiritual foundation of our church. Over time, it became clear that God was already at work—right here among us.

Independent of the APNC's search, Janie Bruce experienced a growing call toward adult ministry through her work with Charleston Atlantic Presbytery and Charleston Youth Mission. With the affirmation of Westminster's Session, she will begin Lay School this spring, working toward commissioning as a Lay Pastor. As Janie's journey came into focus, the committee recognized that God had been preparing someone who deeply loves Westminster, knows our people, works well with our pastoral staff, and is ready to step into leadership with vision and joy.

Janie has been a follower of Jesus for as long as she can remember, grounded in a faith nurtured by family and church. Her ministry has been shaped by a passion for foundation-building, mission, and justice, and by a desire to help others grow confident in who God has created them to be. She describes her call simply: when the Holy Spirit pushes, you jump. Janie is especially excited to invest in leader development, expand mission and justice work, and strengthen Westminster through adult discipleship—believing that faithful adults help form the next generation of disciples. Her guiding scripture is Matthew 6:33–34, a reminder to seek first God's kingdom and trust God's goodness in every season.

The APNC is deeply grateful for the Spirit's guidance throughout this process and gives thanks for its members: Lindy Coleman (Chair), Mark Patrick, Andrew Hopkins, George McAbee, Sandy Pell, and Natasha Akery. We rejoice that God has led Janie Bruce to this role and look forward to the ministry ahead.
