Nigeria

"Persecution is a daily threat for many Christians in Nigeria. Fulani Islamic militants routinely target Christian communities in the central region of the country, burning homes, demolishing churches, displacing families and leaving many Christians without spouses, parents and children. In addition, Boko Haram carries out devastating attacks against Christians in the north in its campaign to drive out Christians and establish an Islamist caliphate governed by Islamic law. But faithful believers continue to follow and serve Christ in Nigeria."

In his interview with VOM, Daniel Zagi, a pastor in Nigeria, used the word pray 42 times. Here's how he said we can pray for believers in northern Nigeria:

-Pray for the safety of Christians sharing the gospel with Muslims

-Pray that Christians will withstand persecution and persevere in their ministry work, regardless of whether incidents of terrorism increase or decrease

-Pray that the Lord will relieve Muslims' fears about what might happen if they become Christians. Help them to understand that for believers, to live is Christ and to die is gain

-Pray that Christians will embrace new converts as their own brothers and sisters
