



Mortgage Liquidation Campaign Update

In January 2019, TPCBC began the Mortgage Liquidation Campaign (MLC) with the vision to liquidate the church's mortgages over a 24-month time period, thereby liberating God's resources for further Kingdom advancement. This campaign is based on the Faith Promises of God's people at TPCBC to commit above and beyond the regular tithes and offerings and to give sacrificially to achieve this goal. By honoring our Faith Promises, we show good stewardship for all that God provides to us.



From the beginning, the campaign has been undergirded by prayer. There is a group of prayer warriors who hold a constant vigil of prayer at 6:21 a.m. and 6:21 p.m. daily to honor Matthew 6:21, which says, *"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."*

The campaign is also covered in prayer by the daily Prayer Line Ministry, and during Tuesday Night Corporate Prayer meetings, Tribal Family meeting prayer time, and personal prayer time of church members.

Since the beginning of the Campaign, TPCBC has seen a wonderful outpouring of commitments and contributions by the congregation that have made a substantial impact on the TPCBC mortgage debts, specifically, the mortgage for the church building. During this time, we have seen:

- A 55% reduction in the mortgage amount for the church building

- 239 congregants made Faith Promises (pledges)
