



Sunday School Fall Studies Update

The 2018-2019 Sunday School year will launch on Sunday, September 9, at 9:45 a.m. in the TPCBC Education wing. Many inspirational, interesting and thought-provoking studies are planned.

The Youth Division begins this day with special kick-off activities, and parents are invited to attend. During the fall quarter, students will explore lessons from Exodus, Numbers, and Joshua, focusing on Bible truths, including: (1) God helps us when we are afraid; (2) God gives us what we need; and (3) God is always with us. Each Sunday students will be given a special activity to complete at home with parents to reiterate the lessons from the study.

The theme for the High School class is “Starting with Trust.” Students will learn about how God makes a difference in our lives, and how He wants us to make a difference in the world.

In the Adult Division, the Understanding the Bible class will focus on a study of the Book of Hebrews entitled, “Finding Life’s Better Things.” The theme for the studies in the Faith Pathways group is, “God’s World and God’s People.” Throughout the quarter, Bible students will survey the book of Genesis, with sessions focusing on God’s creation of the universe, earth and people.

The Special Study group will continue with the chronological study of the Bible entitled, “Read the Bible for Life,” while the Women’s Study Group will begin a new study on Sunday, September 16.
