



## TPCBC Mortgage Liquidation

The Mortgage Liquidation Campaign (MLC) officially launched on January 15, 2019, thanks to unanimous support at the church meeting!

Our belief is that The People's Community Baptist Church should be a cornerstone in the local community. Our church has embarked upon this campaign to liquidate the two mortgages within 24 months so that the church will have the freedom to better serve God's people, expand God's Kingdom and focus on identified needs, such as educational scholarships, local missionaries, domestic violence and the youth.

We need your help, *People's!* We are asking all members to make a Faith Promise above their tithes and offerings by February 28. Please ask an usher for a Faith Promise card before or after worship service, grab a special MLC envelope and place your contribution in the designated collection receptacles.

### Fast Facts

1. The current principal balances on the two mortgages are approximately \$2.2 million.
2. The mortgages mature in 2023.
3. By liquidating the two mortgages by the end of 2020, approximately \$800,000 in interest payments can be saved.
4. The current status of all Faith Promises and contributions received can be seen on the Giving Thermometers on display in the church.
