

Tin Ly – Biography

Ly has been working as a visual artist in South Florida for the past 40 years. He was honored with the Visual and Media Artist Fellowship from **South Florida Cultural Consortium** in 1990 and 1998. He had also received the Individual Artist Fellowship from **Florida Arts Council** in 1986 and 1994. In 2000, **Cultural Foundation of Broward** honored him with a Moretti Award for Artistic Achievement.

Ly, an assistant to the late sculptor Duane Hanson, had worked as the Conservation Manager for the Broward County Public Art & Design Program, 1999-2013. His work has been exhibited in museums and galleries throughout the United States and Hong Kong, and is included in the permanent collection of the Museum of Art - Fort Lauderdale and the Art and Culture Center of Hollywood, and Boca Museum of Art, among others.
