
Primary Care Medical Provider (PCMP) Contracting with NHP

The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing has selected NHP to continue serving as the Regional Accountable Entity (RAE) for Region 2, **effective July 1, 2025**, pending a signed contract.

One major change in the ACC Phase III is that NHP will be serving a larger portion of the state of Colorado!

Existing Counties: Weld, Morgan, Logan, Sedgwick, Phillips, Yuma, Washington, Kit Carson, Lincoln, and Cheyenne.

New Counties: Elbert, Kiowa, Crowley, Otero, Bent, Prowers, Larimer, and Baca.

Our top priority is contracting with any willing PCMPs across our 18 counties.

Here are the overall steps all PCMPs (existing and new) will take to successfully join the network:

1. Ensure enrollment in Health First Colorado (Medicaid).
2. Complete the Practice Assessment by PCMP Practice Site.
3. Submit PCMP Practice Site demographic data, W9, and BAA forms.
4. Review and sign contract sent via DocuSign.

The team has started to reach out to PCMPs with Medicaid enrollment to complete their Practice Assessments.

A key component of the contracting process is for each of your PCMP practice sites within Region 2 to complete a universal ***Practice Assessment*** set by HCPF. This will determine PCMP tier levels which then set monthly PMPM rates for each Practice Site effective July 1, 2025.

HCPF is requiring all RAEs to submit their final PCMP network on April 30, 2025, to administer member attribution effective July 1, 2025.
