

# Temporary Localized Closures

- To protect public health and safety, a turbidity curtain and pumping system have been installed at the CSO-1 outfall to manage water quality impacts to the West Channel.
- As a result, there will be partial obstruction within the West Channel until the permanent solution is complete.
- The turbidity curtain around the pumping system will remain until project completion,
- Upon CSO overflow events, the pumps will clean the water and the channel will be temporarily closed for up to 48 hours to safeguard public safety. Buoys will be deployed to clearly mark restricted areas.
- A portion of the West Channel will be closed up until March 2029.



*Closures are approximately 652 m of the West Channel.*
