**Madison**- Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) issued the following statement after the State Senate passed the legislature's version of the 2025-27 state budget 19-14. The budget includes \$1.3 billion in income tax relief.

"Today's workforce is more mobile than ever. We've all seen the boom that low- and noincome tax states have experienced. Creating and maintaining a competitive tax structure in Wisconsin is the most important economic development tool that we have.
