

## Assembly Floor Session on January 22, 2026

### Assembly bills passed and messaged

[AB-031](#) (Rep. Paul Tittel) – Warranty-related repair and replacement requirements for implements of husbandry.

[AB-315](#) (Rep. Tony Kurtz) – Changes to the Warren Knowles-Gaylord Nelson Stewardship 2000 Program and the creation of a major land acquisition initiative.

[AB-320](#) (Rep. Scott Allen) – Raising certain court feed and surcharges and adjusting those amounts annually for inflation.

[AB-415](#) (Rep. Dan Knodl) – Restrictions on how state and local government-issued electronic devices may be used.

[AB-459](#) (Rep. Jerry O'Connor) – Updating county requirements for public works notifications and competitive bidding thresholds.

[AB-472](#) (Rep. Shae Sortwell) – Creating a nuclear energy generation tax credit; prioritizing nuclear power resources; approving specific electric tariffs for very large customers; and allowing utilities to recover certain precertification costs through rates.

[AB-605](#) (Rep. Brent Jacobson) – Allowing certain municipal solid waste facilities to retain environmental repair fees.

[AB-612](#) (Rep. Tony Kurtz) – Modifications to the Warren Knowles-Gaylord Nelson Stewardship 2000 Program, establishment of a major land acquisitions program, and providing an appropriation.

[AB-623](#) (Rep. Calvin Callahan) – Implementing a series of updates to insurance statutes.

[AB-662](#) (Rep. Alex Dallman) – Prohibiting state agencies from contracting with certain business entities and establishing penalties.

[AB-663](#) (Rep. Alex Dallman) – Imposing restrictions on foreign influence withing University of Wisconsin System institutions.

[AB-668](#) (Rep. Barbara Dittrich) – Requiring competency reports for involuntarily committed individuals refusing medication or treatment based on evaluations by advanced practice registered nurses.

[AB-672](#) (Rep. Clint Moses) – Creating a penalty enhancer for crimes committed on behalf of a foreign government or terrorist organization to suppress political views; prohibiting enforcement of foreign laws without federal or state approval; and establishing penalties.

[AB-673](#) (Rep. Clint Moses) – Banning the use of genetic software from foreign adversaries in medical or research settings and prohibiting human genome sequencing data from being stored within those countries; and creating penalties.

[AB-674](#) (Rep. Clint Moses) – Prohibiting health insurance policies and Medicaid from covering organ transplants or related care if the organ is sourced from or transplanted in a country known for forced organ harvesting.

[AB-749](#) (Rep. Benjamin Franklin) – Requiring instruction on blood and organ donation in high school curricula.

### **Senate bills passed and messaged**

[SB-007](#) (Sen. Andre Jacque) - Prohibiting foreign adversaries from purchasing agricultural or forestry land in Wisconsin.

[SB-078](#) (Sen. Andre Jacque) – Regulating the distribution and labeling of fertilizers and soil or plan additives derived from manure.

[SB-448](#) (Sen. Jesse James) – Authorizing the use of videoconferencing technology in certain civil court proceedings.

[SB-459](#) (Sen. Van Wanggaard) – Establishing standards for the admissibility of expert witness testimony.

[SB-504](#) (Sen. Mary Felzkowski) – Regulating the rental of dental provider networks by insurance plans.

[SB-593](#) (Sen. Romaine Quinn) Enacting various revisions to insurance laws.
