

## Assembly Floor Session on January 20, 2026

### Assembly bills passed and messaged

[AB-253](#) (Rep. Robert Brooks) – Establishing and regulating independence accounts.

[AB-393](#) (Rep. Shae Sortwell) – Rules for school bus operation by drivers over age 70 and drivers with certain medical conditions.

[AB-554](#) (Rep. Clint Moses) – Requirements for selling, serving, and labeling food products made with lab-grown animal cells, including penalties.

[AB-564](#) (Rep. Rob Summerfield) – Authorizing chiropractors to conduct health examinations required for school employees.

[AB-572](#) (Rep. Alex Dallman) – Updates the statutory definition of bingo.

[AB-650](#) (Committee on Workforce Development, Labor, and Integrated Employment) – Funding identity-verification processes under unemployment insurance and making an appropriation.

[AB-651](#) (Committee on Workforce Development, Labor, and Integrated Employment) – Modifying various provisions of the worker’s compensation law, granting rule-making authority, and establishing related penalties.

[AB-652](#) (Committee on Workforce Development, Labor, and Integrated Employment) – Making several changes to unemployment insurance statutes.

[AB-666](#) (Rep. Jerry O'Connor) – Addressing fraudulent claims for unclaimed property and creating penalties.

[AB-699](#) (Rep. Kevin Petersen) – Creating a long-term care insurance assessment and a corresponding tax credit.

[AB-700](#) (Rep. Kevin Petersen) – Funding refundable credits related to long-term care insurance assessments and making an appropriation.

[AB-840](#) (Rep. Shannon Zimmerman) – Establishing certain requirements relating to data centers.

**Senate bills passed and messaged**

[SB-188](#) (Sen. Dan Feyen) – Reducing the penalty surcharge when certain fines or forfeitures are lowered.

[SB-387](#) (Sen. Andre Jacque) – Adding veteran status indicators to operators’ licenses and state identification cards for eligible service members.

[SB-482](#) (Sen. Dan Feyen) – Extending the period during which unused research income tax credits may be carried forward.

[SB-533](#) (Sen. Jesse James) – Criminalizing the intentional disarming of a correctional officer and establishing penalties.
