



Community Commitment 2021-2022 Giving Guide

It's now time to make an informed and values-based **Community Commitment** to Makom Solel Lakeside. As previously announced, there are no set dues amount – your household's commitment is up to you.

Your commitment will be for the upcoming fiscal year, July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022. This single financial commitment to the community covers all that Makom Solel Lakeside has to offer, **including Lev Learning religious school** – there will be no separate school fees.


We ask that you make your annual **Community Commitment** and register for the upcoming religious school year (if applicable) by **June 30, 2021**.

Please use this **Giving Guide** to determine your amount based upon ability, values, and the spirit of philanthropy. Our collective contributions will promote growth and sustainability for Makom Solel Lakeside.

\$1,800 (\$150/month)	A suggested minimum giving amount
\$3,600 (\$300/month)	A suggested sustaining giving amount to cover the operating expenses per household, with subsidies from other available financial resources
\$4,500 (\$375/month)	A suggested giving amount to cover 100% of the operating expenses per household; based on Makom Solel Lakeside's operating costs divided by the number of households
\$7,200+ (\$600+/month)	A suggested giving amount to cover 100% of the operating expenses per household and also provide additional support to the community
Other	We offer all community members the option of contributing a different giving amount that is meaningful to you

There will still be additional fees (e.g., B'nai Mitzvah, dinners and special events) as well as additional giving opportunities (e.g., security, Shalom Circle, pandemic response).
