



Important Information for this Sunday's Dance Directive!

- Be sure to bring all of your dance shoes.
- You can wear any kind of dance attire. Bring/wear layers as you may want to wear different things for different classes. Be sure to dress like a dancer, but you don't have to wear your company uniform!

EVENT VENUE

Classes will be held on Sunday, October 15 at the Overland Park Convention Center, 6000 College Blvd. Parking and entrance to the venue is on the lower level north side. Registration will be on the upper level outside the Advanced and Intermediate classrooms, Ballrooms A and B. The Beginner classroom will be on the lower level in Courtyard Rooms 5-7.

CHECK- IN

Check-in/registration begins at 7:15 am and should be done by a studio director/teacher for the entire studio (not by students individually). Wristbands for students, studio teacher/directors, and pre-purchased observers will be given to the person checking in for the studio. That person will then assume responsibility for passing out all appropriate wristbands to members of his/her studio. Additional Observer wristbands will be available for purchase at the door for \$25 each, and are non-transferable. Wristbands will be required for entry into any of the dance rooms.

WARM UP

Each class level will warm up individually in the appropriate classroom beginning at 7:50 am.

LEVEL CHANGES

After an hour or so of classes you may find that a student or two are better suited at a different level than originally placed. You'll find us to be flexible in moving students as needed (with studio teacher approval). Students moving up a level will be required to pay the difference in class fees (beginner to intermediate \$20, intermediate to advanced \$10). Students moving down a level will not be refunded.

WATER

Water will be available to the students throughout the day, although we encourage each student to bring a water bottle (no glass) marked with his or her name to drink from.

LUNCH BREAK

Lunch will not be provided. This means you will have 2 options for lunch: 1) Leave the facility (with an adult of course) to eat; or 2) Bring a sack lunch.

TEACHER AND PARENT CLASSES

Please note the schedule includes special classes for teachers and parents. No pre-registration is required, just show up at the scheduled time. The Teacher class is open to studio teachers and directors with a studio director/teacher bracelet. The Parent portion of the class is free and open to any and all who would like to attend. The Beginner level classroom will be converted to the Teacher, Parent and Tap classroom during the afternoon sessions.

TAP CLASSES

Tap classes for the Intermediate and Advanced level dancers will be offered as an option during the afternoon sessions in the converted Beginner classroom. Those who choose not to participate in Tap will stay in their regular designated level classroom for the afternoon sessions.

SCHOLARSHIP PRESENTATIONS

Selected dancers will receive scholarships and other recognition following the conclusion of the final class period. Their "audition" will literally be their participation throughout the day. Master Teachers will be watching for hard workers, enthusiasm and demonstration of learned skills. Please remember, however, that the primary focus of the day is learning, networking, and enjoying new experiences, not receiving "awards".
