Kellerman (1992) described four psychodramatist's roles and skills that we, at Therapeutic Spiral International (TSI), integrated into our team roles in 1994 for all Therapeutic Spiral Model (TSM) dramas. This workshop offers participants an opportunity to experience these roles in action:

- Analyst, who has theoretical knowledge and empathic understanding;
- Producer, who creates an aesthetic and safe theater production;
- Therapist, who uses safe clinical interventions for healing;
- Group leader/Sociometrist, who manages and enhances group process and experience.

These skills are necessary in all therapeutic settings, especially in the expressive arts because of the emotional intensity of material that is evoked and the intricacies of group process. Participants become aware of their preferred mode, note the areas they need to expand into and enhance, and practice all.

This workshop is open to students and practitioners of psychodrama and other experiential methods. Hours for TSI certification, psychodrama with American Board of Examiners in Psychodrama, Sociometry & Group Psychotherapy; experiential therapy through American Society of Experiential Therapists.
