### Where do I order Coats for Kids?

Coats are available through Supplies Online, the supply ordering portal available on [Officers Online](#) in the United States and [knightsgear.ca](#) in Canada.

### Who has access to order the coats?

Grand Knights, Financial Secretaries, and Program Directors in the United States.

### How much is the cost of shipping?

Price of shipping is included in the cost of the coats.

### How can my council receive featured program credit for this program?

By purchasing six (6) or more cases of coats of any style in the United States or four (4) or more cases of coats in Canada. Yes, they could be mixed styles.

### Can I still receive one credit if I order from a different vendor or less than 6 cases in the United States and 4 in Canada?

Yes, you will still receive one credit towards the Columbian award if you purchase less than the required amount.
