A Message From the Appleton Health Department

We will be holding two COVID-19 vaccination clinics for kids who are 5-11 years old next week, Thursday and Friday (November 18th and 19th). We are not sending the information and link to register out to the general public, but are sending it directly to the Appleton schools - please see attached flyer.

These clinics run from 3-6pm, at our current Appleton COVID-19 clinic

site, which is located in the former Best Buy on Kensington Drive in Appleton. It will be appointment only, due to staffing constraints and vaccine supply that we currently have on hand. If families are not able to attend these clinics, they do have other opportunities to get their children vaccinated in our area. After the clinic on November 19, we will continue to have the vaccine available at our regular Thursday and Friday clinics. These clinics do have times before and/or after school if preferred. It is

also available via local pharmacies (Walgreen, CVS, Smith pharmacy to name a few).
