

Happy Easter!

I hope everyone had a blessed Easter and an enjoyable Spring Break! We certainly had some wonderful weather during break week. It made even a stay-cation a joy!

We are entering a couple weeks that can be considered the calm before the (activity) storm. The rest of April is relatively quiet in regard to activities. We will, however, be doing a couple of activities to celebrate this Easter season. On Friday of this week, we will gather to introduce the Divine Mercy prayer to our students. Since we just
