6 and partnership opportunities that support the age friendly city initiatives
7 and the development of unique opportunities for individuals with special
8 needs.

10 E. Support any legislation requesting funding assistance and
11 partnership opportunities for projects that enhance mobility and create a
12 network of interconnected lanes in support of bicycle and pedestrian
13 activity within the Village.

15 F. Seeking funding assistance for the Village's FRDAP and
16 other such FDEP projects to address park capital improvements and park
17 property acquisitions.


19 G. Seeking relief from homeowner insurance rates which are
20 slated to increase by 8.2%, substantially higher than what most residents
21 can afford, the Village supports and requests rate relief and reforms.

24 provides wage increases to all State employees in Miami-Dade County,
25 by recognizing that the cost of living in South Florida is substantially
26 higher than rural areas of Florida. Through this request, the State can
27 keep its employees longer and not lose the training and knowledge
28 accumulated by them.



30 I. The Village requests funding for mental health funding for
