Ordinance requesting two changes:

- 1: Eliminate Sunset Date**
- 2: Increase rate from 3.5% to 6%**



- **Benchmark customer who consumes 1,000 kilowatt hours will pay about \$100/month to FPL**
- **At 3.5% the Village of Palmetto bay's Franchise Fee per household would be \$3.50/Month or \$42.00/Year.**



- Changing the rate to 6% would be a 2.5% increase
- That would be an **additional \$2.50/month (\$30/year)** to the benchmark FPL customer and approximately \$800,000 to the Village.

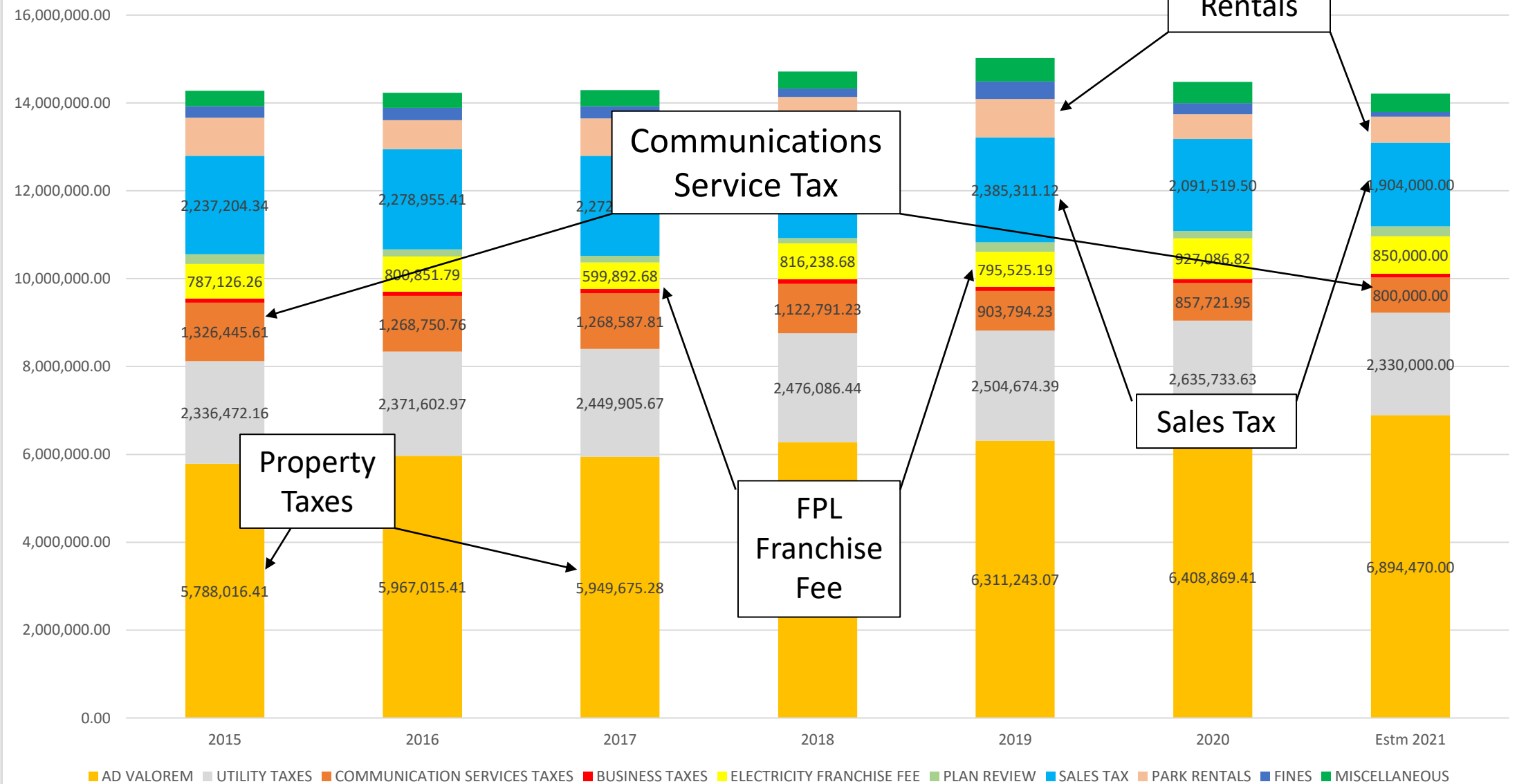

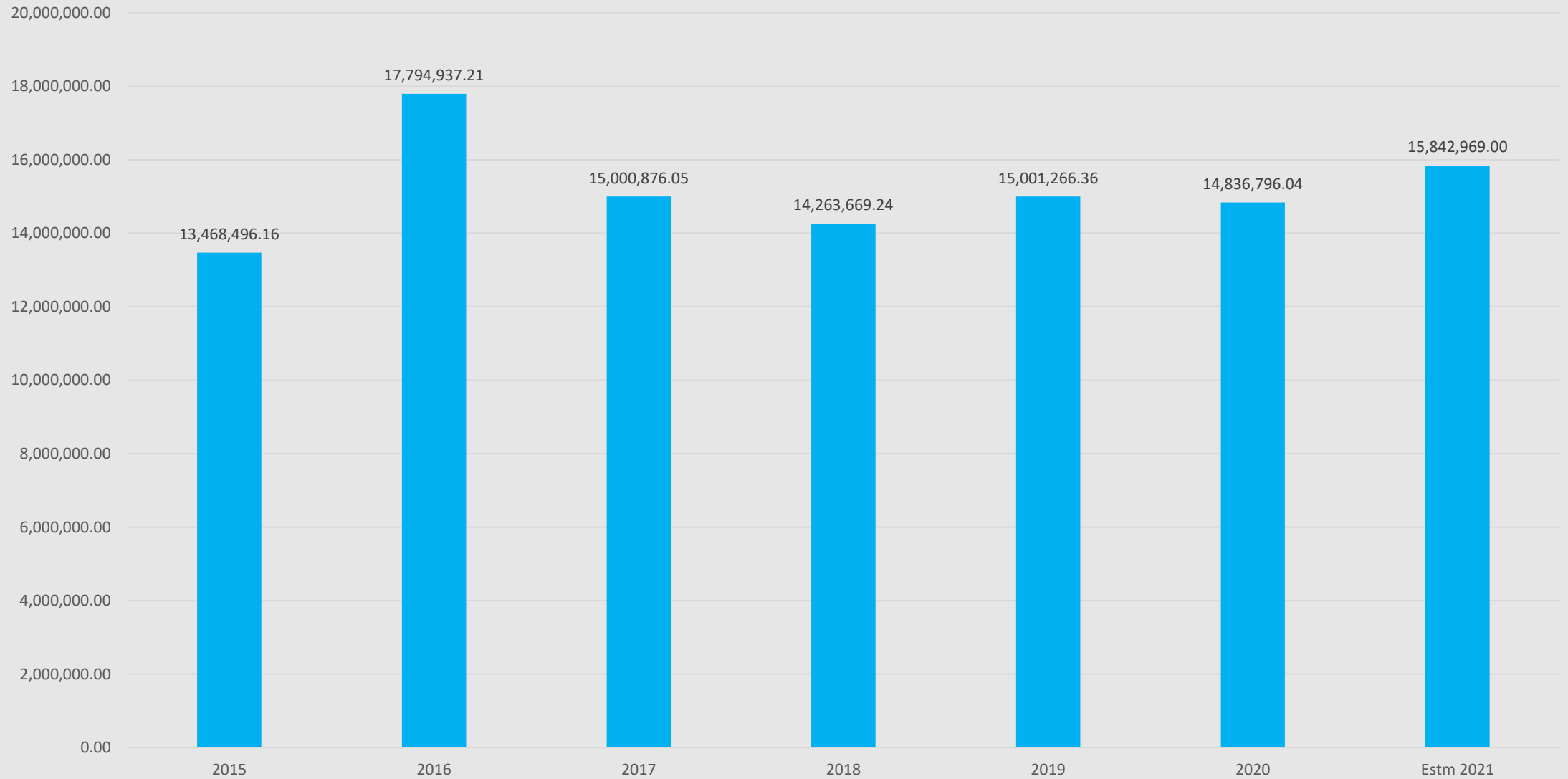
Revenue Sources:

- Fines and Forfeitures
- Other/Miscellaneous

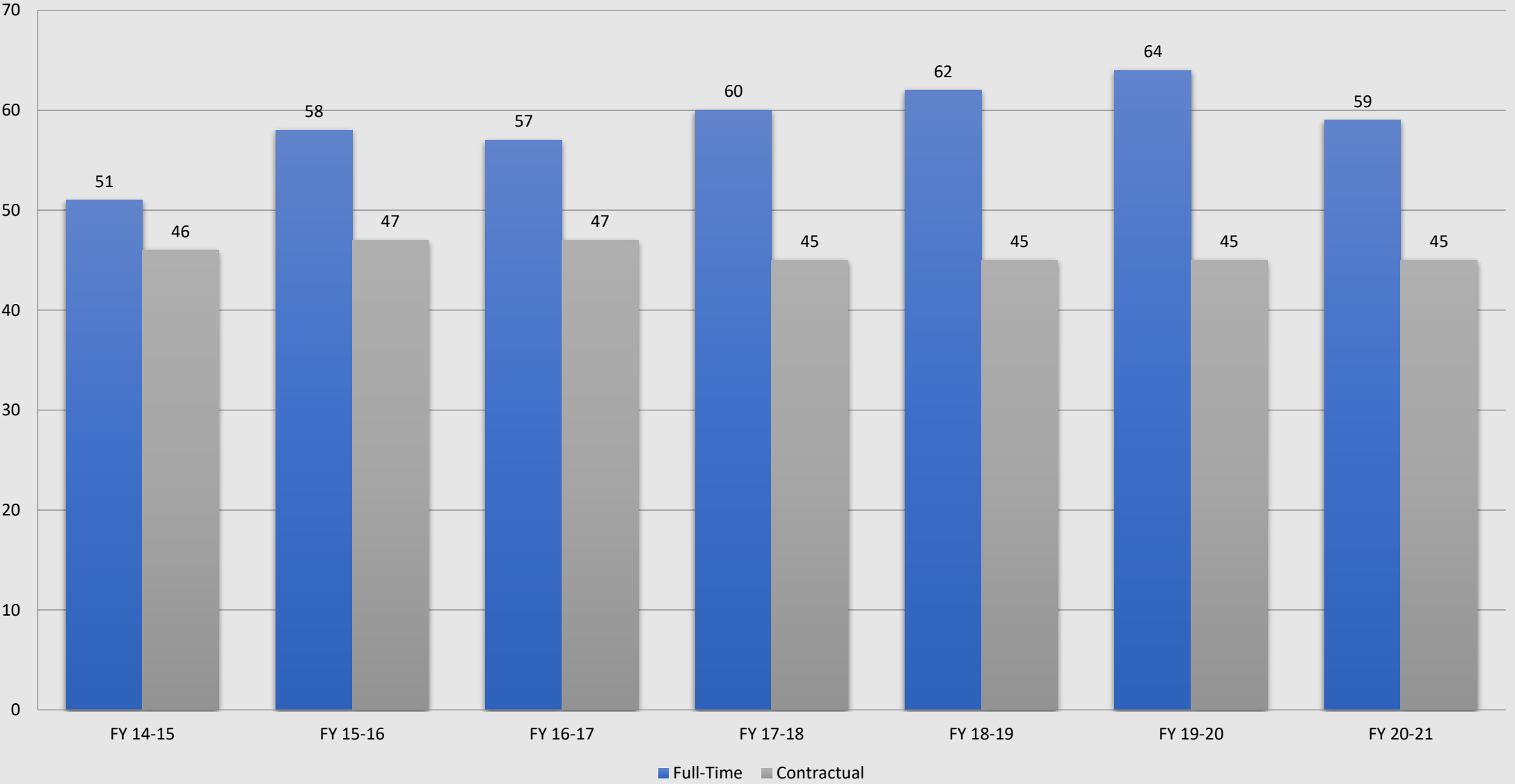
GENERAL FUND REVENUES



GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES



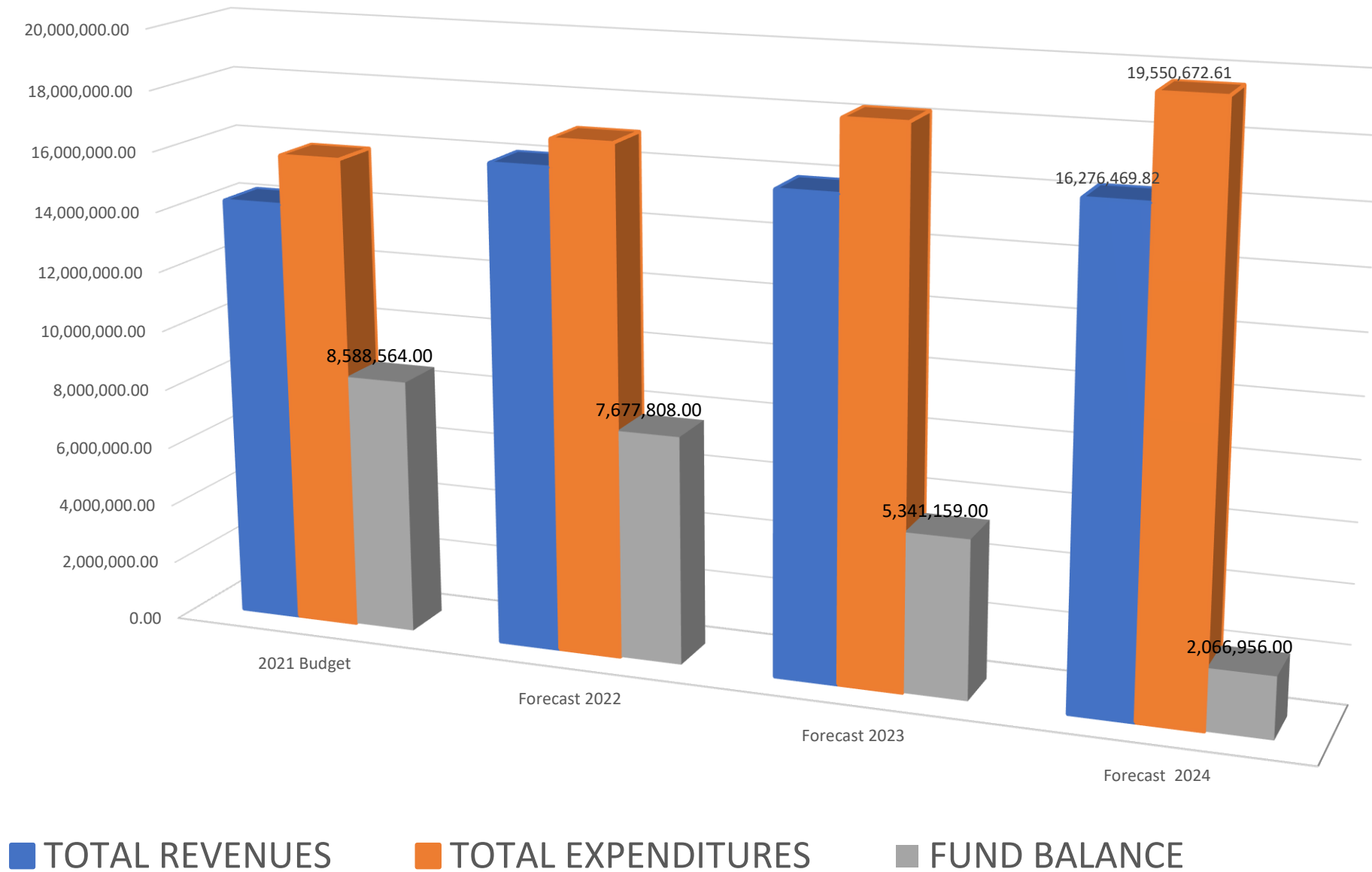
PERSONNEL CHANGES



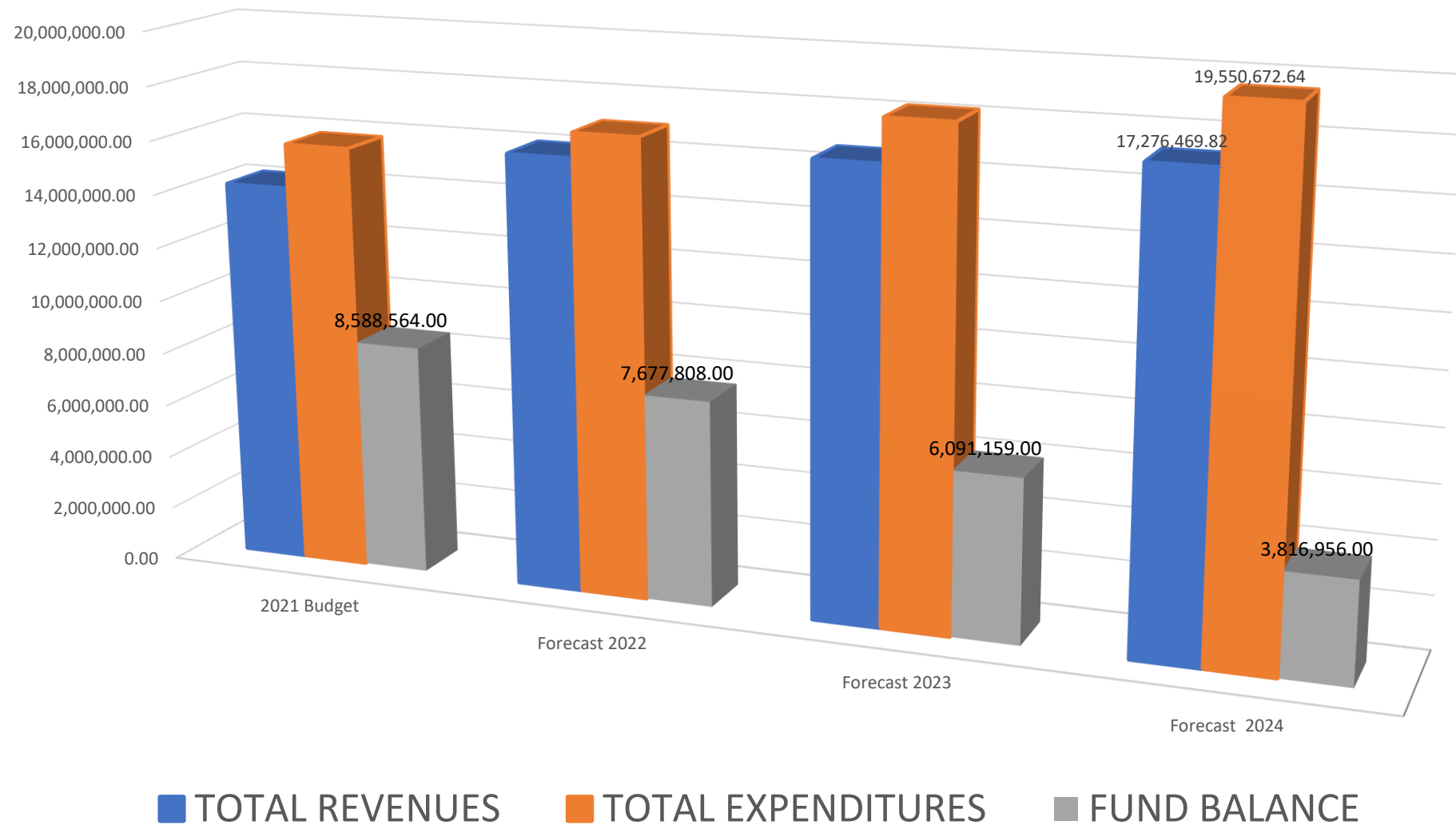

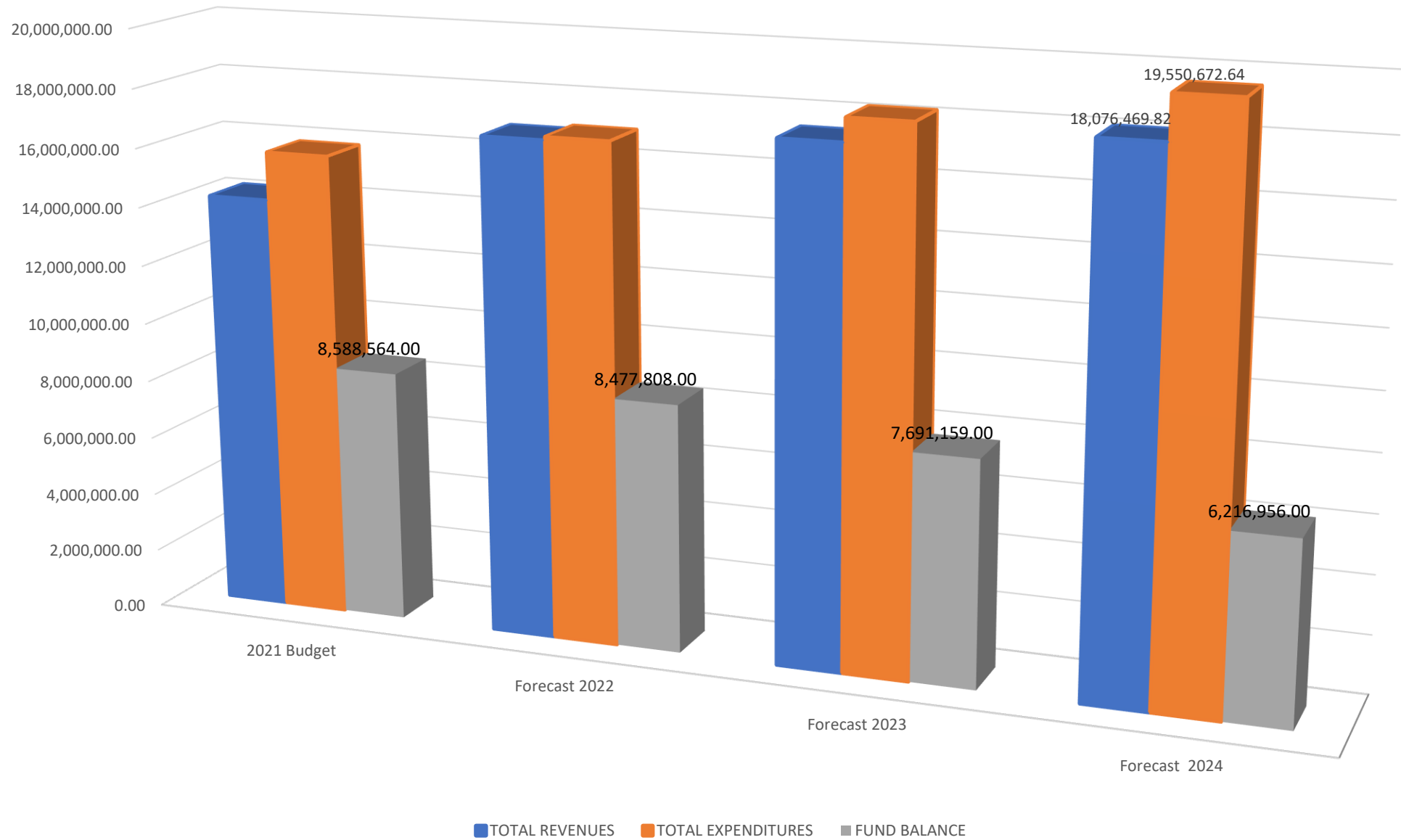
General Fund Forecast with FPL Current Rate and Sunset

American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA)

Qualifying Uses

- Respond to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19 or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel and hospitality
- For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue due to the public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year
- Make necessary investments in water, sewer or broadband infrastructure, or
- Include premium pay for eligible workers performing essential work during the pandemic
