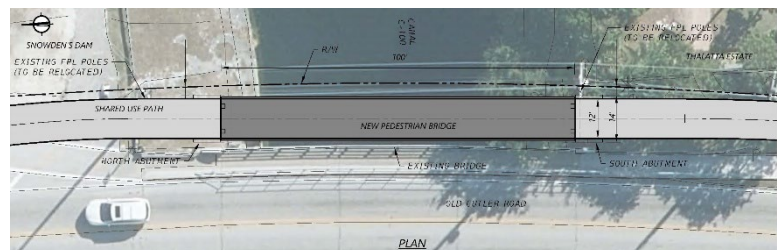
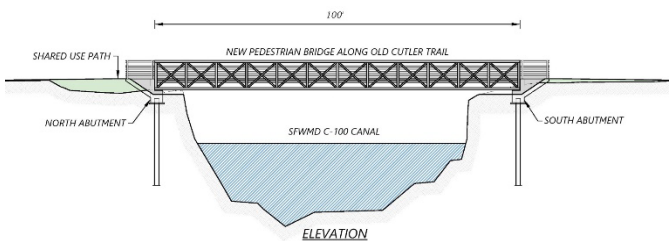
Snowden Pedestrian Bridge

NEW PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE ALONG OLD CUTLER TRAIL

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Located along the popular Old Cutler Trail just north of SW 174th Street, over the C-100 Canal, and next to the existing bridge within Miami-Dade County Commission District 8, the project highlights DTPW's ongoing commitment to enhancing community well-being and public safety through strategic infrastructure investments. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, installing a new, wider prefabricated pedestrian bridge, constructing abutments and approach slabs, installing lighting, updating signage and pavement markings, sodding, and enhancing the drainage system.

This new, expanded pedestrian bridge (shown below) will significantly enhance accessibility and safety for the numerous pedestrians and bicyclists who use the Old Cutler Trail for recreation or commuting. The wider bridge will better accommodate two-way pedestrian and bicycle traffic, reduce congestion, and provide a safer and better-connected mobility experience for all users. By improving this critical segment of the Old Cutler Trail, DTPW is not only fostering safer, more connected neighborhoods but also supporting healthier, more sustainable modes of transportation.



CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE:

Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2025* and is expected to be completed by June 2026*.

**The start and end dates of this work may be significantly impacted by labor and material shortages, as well as by weather events characteristic of the hurricane season.*

METHODOLOGY AND EFFORTS:

All efforts are being made to minimize the impact from the construction activities to area residents, schools, businesses, and motorists. The area will be restored to its original condition immediately upon the completion of the construction activities. The restoration activities will address any areas impacted by the project, such as grassy areas, landscaping and other items affected by the construction.
