

# Village of Palmetto Bay Parks & Recreation



## PARK RULES



Following the recommendations from Miami-Dade County, the Village of Palmetto Bay is moving to a new normal easing restrictions on select parks and trails for passive activities and limited recreation.

Current CDC and State Health Department guidelines regarding the use of masks, 6 feet of social distancing between individuals and limit of groups to 10 people or fewer, must be followed.

Sports Skills and Drill Practice (in groups of less than ten, to include, but is not limited to, activities such as shooting a basketball, dribbling a soccer ball, family members throwing a ball, or similar activities, and Summer Camps and Youth Sports/Programming if conducted in conformance with Miami Dade County Emergency Order 23-20, as amended, and the Moving to A New Normal Handbook incorporated into that order)		Gatherings (No groups of 10 or more shall congregate in parks or recreational facilities. All persons, excepting family, shall observe social distancing of six feet apart, both within groups and with others.)

Tennis courts (singles, and doubles play.)		Water Fountains	
Racquet Ball (singles and doubles play.)		Outdoor Exercise Equipment	
Restrooms (open for sure by one person or one family at a time.)		Competitive Sports (No pick-up games, scrimages, organized or competitive play on courts or fields will be allowed.)	
Facial Coverings (are required to be carried in all Village of Palmetto Bay parks and shall be worn if social distancing is not possible. The following are exempt from wearing facial coverings; children under the age of 2, persons who have trouble breathing due to a chronic pre-existing condition, or persons engaged in strenuous physical activity.)		No table games, picnics, parties.	
Youth Sports & Programming (only those that can be conducted in small groups (Total of not more than 10 athletes/participant and/ other personnel) for skills and drills only, and with adequate spacing (minimum of 1 person per 10 ft are allowed following the Miami Dade County Emergency Order 23-20, as amended, and the Moving to A New Normal Handbook incorporated into that order.)
