



PARK RULES



Following the recommendations from Miami-Dade County, the Village of Palmetto Bay is moving to a new normal easing restrictions on select parks and trails for passive activities and limited recreation.

Patrons are encouraged to use parks for individual and family passive and limited activities.

Current CDC and State Health Department guidelines regarding the use of masks, 6 feet of social distancing between individuals and limit of groups to 10 people or fewer, must be followed.

Village of Palmetto Bay Parks & Recreation - Limited Activities Use Reminder

- Coral Reef Park and Palmetto Bay Park will be available for limited use by all visitors from 7 AM - 8 PM, Monday through Sunday.
- The main parking lot and the east side (77th avenue entrance) parking lot will be open at Coral Reef Park from 7 AM until 8 PM, Monday through Sunday. Signage at each entrance of the parking lots will be displayed with hours and rules.
- Parking lot at Palmetto Bay Park will remain closed.
- All persons visiting the parks and park staff will follow CDC/Health Department protocols and guidelines to include but not limited to six-foot social distancing, use of face masks, and other personal protective equipment.
- Visitors to these parks are encouraged to use the park for 1- or 2-hour intervals.
- Batting Cages closed.
- Walking and Nature Paths will be one way (directional).
- Tennis Courts will be open for singles play and private one on one lessons only.
- Racquet Ball Courts will be open for individual play only. Competitive games are prohibited.
- Coral Reef Park canoe and kayak launch will be open.
- Restrooms Closed.
- Visitors are encouraged to bring water bottles as water fountains will be out of service.
- No recreational programming, pick-up games, organized sports, or activities will be allowed.
- No groups of 10 or more will be allowed in parks; smaller groups must maintain social distancing following CDC/Health Department guidelines.
- Park Staff will take extra measures to keep open facilities clean and sanitized in accordance with CDC/Health Department guidelines of six-foot social distancing.
- Virtual recreational programming will continue on-line.
- No person shall violate the terms of this Emergency Order, except upon direct authorization of the Village of Palmetto Bay Policing Unit. Any violation of this Emergency Order shall be subject to fine, imprisonment, or both, and/or closure of the Essential Business in accordance with Section 14-88 of the Village Code.
- Activities at the parks will be limited to a walking, jogging, cycling and hiking on trails.
