

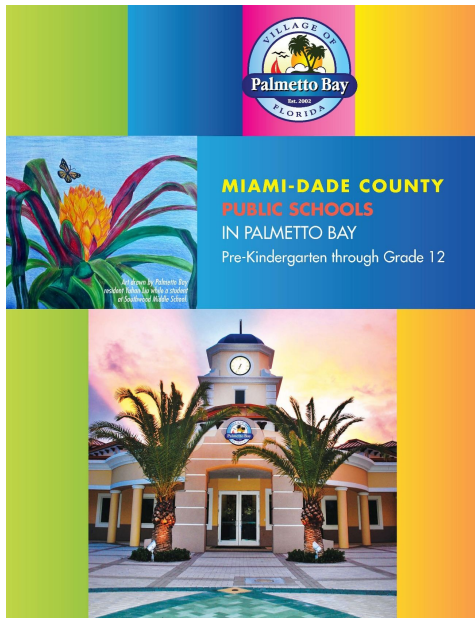


COMMITTEE MEMBER WANTED EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE (“EAC”)

If you are interested in volunteering or becoming more involved in your community, consider joining the Education Advisory Committee. The Village of Palmetto Bay is currently accepting applications for a prospective committee member.

Purpose/Mission:

The Education Advisory Committee formerly known as the Educational Compact Advisory Board entered into an Education Compact with Miami Dade County Public Schools via Resolution 2013-63 on September 9, 2013, to bring together each organization’s collective resources for the benefit of the students and residents within the Village.



Members of the Education Advisory Committee are appointed by Palmetto Bay Village Council. This committee serves the Village by reviewing and supporting the terms of the Education Compact that was entered into between the Village and Miami-Dade County Public Schools and is bound by the State of Florida Sunshine Laws. This board meets, at a minimum, the last Tuesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. at Village Hall Municipal Center, except for holidays observed by MDCPS.

Membership/Qualifications:

The committee is to be composed of five (5) members. The members shall have experience, training, or knowledge in the field of Education. Appointees must be residents of the Village, with the exception of a registered Dade Partner, and cannot be members of any other Village Board, Committee, or Task Force. Appointees must have at least one criteria from the following categories:

- (i) a resident who is a parent with a child currently attending a public school in the Village;
- (ii) a resident who has taught for a minimum of three (3) years in a MDCPS public school in Miami-Dade County;
- (iii) a business owner in the Village that is a registered Dade Partner with a public school in the Village;
- (iv) a resident with a Bachelor’s Degree, or a Master’s Degree in Education, Educational Leadership or related education degree and is currently working in or retired from MDCPS.

Residents interested in applying to serve on the EAC must provide a resume, a list of qualifications including the submittal of an Advisory Board/Committee Application to the Office of the Village Clerk at: clerk@palmettobay-fl.gov.
