**Registration fees:** \$40 for all SLW participants (includes members, advisers, chaperones)

Lodging fees: \$255 (taxes & hotel fees included) per room per night, 1 to 4 in a room.

Included: 1 waterpark pass (\$120 value) per person registered to a guestroom

**Included:** Resort fees; additional 24-hour security

Payment due: October 17, 2022 (projected)
