We will be studying Natural History.

This course is an introduction to the flora and fauna of the Angeles National Forest held at RHP's camping facility at Mount Kare. In this week long course, students will work with a team and survey an area in the forest where they will take pictures of the living organisms around them. Teams will identify and classify different types of birds, mammals, reptiles, herbs, shrubs, and trees. Photographs with scientific names are given in a media presentation for part of the team grade. Dichotomous keys, taxonomy, ecological terms, and the map of California are part of the topics covered.
