



## RHP Science Camps Behavior Contract

It is the expectation of Rio Hondo Prep that students abide by the behavioral guidelines as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook and those rules and expectations listed below:

1. Students are required to conduct themselves with maturity, courtesy, and respect towards all parties at science camps, including, but not limited to, classmates, teachers, chaperones, camp/hotel staff, guides, and those in the general public.
2. Students are required to follow the instructions of their chaperones and teachers **at all times**, realizing chaperones and teachers are responsible for student safety and the safety of the group.
3. Students must attend all group activities, including meals, lectures, meetings, and other scheduled group events.
4. Students must actively participate in class sessions, complete assignments, and behave themselves so as to not disrupt class sessions and activities in any way.
5. Students must remain in their assigned rooms from curfew until a time in the morning designated by staff. Students cannot enter rooms of the opposite gender at any time.
6. Students must respect public, private, and personal property at all times. Any damages incurred to public, private, or personal property as a result of student conduct will be the financial responsibility of the student.
7. Freshmen students may not bring cell phones or other electronic devices to Arizona, with the exception of dedicated cameras. Sophomore, junior, and senior students may bring cameras and cell phones to Mt. Kare but phones cannot be used during class, meal services, group meetings, or in cabins. All other electronic devices (tablets, laptops, video game consoles, etc.) are prohibited.

Teachers and chaperones reserve the right to exclude a student from any and all activities if student behavior is disrespectful, dangerous, illegal, or violates behavioral expectations.

Teachers and chaperones reserve the right to search students' personal belongings and rooms during the camp to ensure that no prohibited items are in students' possession.
