YOUR APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING...

- Equals 35 college credits in SVCC's Industrial Maintenance Technician curriculum
- Must be paired with a total of 8,000 hours of on-the-job training

COMPLETE YOUR DEGREE...

With 31 credits of coursework:

- Orientation – 1 credit
- 2 English Courses – 6 credits
- 1 Humanities Course – 3 credits
- 2 Social Sciences Courses – 6 credits
- 1 Mathematics Course – 3 credits
- 1 Computer Applications Course – 3 credits
- 3 Technical Elective Courses – 9 credits

All of the above courses are offered online. Students may take electives that match their individual career goals.
