Position Overview

Prince of Peace Lutheran Church is seeking a positive, faith-filled Summer Music Ministry Intern to assist primarily with our children's and youth music from mid-July through mid-September. This position is ideal for a college student or young adult interested in church music, music education, worship leadership and/or youth ministry.

The intern will work closely with the Director of Worship Arts and church staff to help lead and support summer music programming, including the children's music camp, worship music, rehearsals and other music activities.

The employee will support and advance the mission of Prince of Peace by helping build disciples of Jesus who know God, grow together, and serve the world. Through their leadership, relationships, and daily responsibilities, this individual will encourage people to know God through worship, prayer, and engagement with His Word; foster Christ-centered community where believers grow together in faith; and inspire service to the world through faithful witness, compassionate action, and generous stewardship. All aspects of this role should reflect and reinforce the congregation's commitment to making and maturing disciples of Jesus Christ.

Qualifications

- Must be 18 years or older
- Committed to Christ and His church by word and example
- Comfortable working with children, youth, and adults
- Positive, enthusiastic, encouraging, and dependable
- Musical experience (at PoP) preferred (vocal and/or instrumental)
- Ability to work collaboratively with staff and volunteers
- Comfortable helping lead group activities and basic music instruction

Preferred Skills

- Singing and/or instrumental proficiency
- Experience working with children or youth
- Basic organizational and communication skills
- Interest in church music, worship, music education, or ministry leadership



Duties

- Develop positive relationships with children, youth, families, and volunteers
- Assist in planning and leading the church's summer music camp
- Help teach songs, lead music activities, and assist with simple choreography or movement at music camp (afternoons, August 3rd – 7th)
- Prepare music, materials, and supplies for rehearsals
- Assist with children's choir and youth music activities as needed
- Support worship services through singing, instrumental participation, or worship leadership assistance
- Encourage and support participation in music ministry programs
- Help organize music library materials, instruments, databases and rehearsal spaces
- Serve as a positive Christian role model to children and families
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Worship Arts

- Hands-on experience in church music ministry
- Leadership and teaching experience
- Worship planning and rehearsal experience
- Experience working with children and families in a faith-based environment
- Mentorship from church music and ministry leaders
- Through this internship, the intern will gain practical ministry experience while growing as a disciple of Jesus Christ. The intern will have opportunities to deepen their relationship with God through worship, prayer, and engagement with Scripture; develop leadership and relational skills within a Christ-centered community; and learn how to serve the world through faithful witness, compassionate action, and generous stewardship. By participating in the life and ministry of Prince of Peace, the intern will gain hands-on experience in helping others know God, grow together in faith, and serve their neighbors in Christ's name.
